Subject: Special City Council Meeting to consider the repeal of all land use entitlements for the Harmony Specific Plan and withdrawal of the Referendum measure [*Specific Plan SPR-011-001 (Ordinance No. 409), General Plan Amendment GPA-011-003 (Resolution No. 2016-047), Zone Change ZC-011-003 (Ordinance No. 408), Tentative Tract Maps TTM-012-001 (Resolution No. 2016-048 & Resolution No. 2016-049), Development Agreement DA-012-002 (Ordinance No. 410), and Environmental Impact Report ENV014-002 (Resolution No. 2016-046)*].

To whom it may concern:

This courtesy letter is being mailed to you because you have requested to be notified of all actions concerning the Harmony Specific Plan Application in the City of Highland, and/or your contact information has been provided to the City for notification purposes.

To implement the court's recent rulings in the lawsuits challenging the Environmental Impact Report prepared for the Harmony Specific Plan project, the Applicants (Lewis Group of Companies and Orange County) have requested, and the City staff will recommend, that the City Council repeal all land use entitlements and approvals for the Harmony project. The recommended repeal will include the two ordinances that are the subject of the referendum and, if they are repealed, the City will request that the referendum measure be withdrawn.

The City of Highland City Council will consider these actions at a Special City Council meeting scheduled for **August 8, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall Council Chambers located at 27215 Base Line, Highland, CA 92346.**

The Staff Report and documents related to the Applicant's request will be available to the public at least 72 hours prior to the scheduled Special City Council meeting.
